Daily routine

We have a structured daily routine that the children follow using a visual timetable. On arrival children are encouraged to be as independent as possible, placing their coats and bags in designated areas before completing their "check-in" procedures. Part- Time Nursery children will be met at the Main Reception at 12:15pm by Miss Johnson and Mrs Walker.

How and what we learn

In the designated areas set up within our classroom the children are encouraged to investigate and explore learning experiences alongside their peers with the support of the adults. The modelling of patterns and co-operative play work hand in hand with specific language learning, helping the children to develop their understanding and confidence when using English and Welsh as their natural tongue and Welsh as a second language for the English stream children. A wide variety of play-based activities are offered to the children to enhance their learning and to ensure they are developing with appropriate challenge.

There will be a designated time in the day for pupils to have their snack. We ask kindly that all snacks brought to school are healthy. Children can also bring in 30p to buy fruit at the fruit trolley. Children will help themselves to milk during the afternoons to support independence.

P.E lessons

P.E lessons will take place every Friday morning. Appropriate kit and footwear are essential for pupils to participate. We ask that all items of clothing are labelled so that they are easy to find if lost. Children can come to school in their uniform and the children will change in school.
